

MAT Registered Nurse Program Coordinator

Summary:

This position is primarily responsible for providing patient care and care coordination for adults with opioid use disorder receiving medication assisted treatment. Care coordination of opioid-dependent patients comprises at least 50% of the job function. Program coordination comprises the rest of the job function. This includes fulfillment of grant requirements, policy and procedure writing, implementing new workflows, and other program administration needs. Managing other projects and/or assisting with other clinic nursing duties may be required. This position reports to the Registered Nurse Manager.

Education and/or Experience:

Bachelor's degree in nursing (B.S.N.) from a four-year college or university and public health nurse (PHN) registration for the State of Minnesota, preferred.

Two years of experience in providing nursing care coordination, preferred.

Experience working with chemically-dependent adults and knowledge of harm reduction principles, preferred.
