The Health Care for the Homeless Project provides health maintenance, outreach and acute care services to homeless men, women, infants and children. The Hennepin County Public Health Clinic provides confidential diagnosis and treatment of sexually transmitted infections (STIs), testing and counseling for HIV, treatment for tuberculosis and latent TB infections (LTBIs), and health screening for newly arrived refugees.

Primary Duties and Responsibilities

Hennepin County Public Health is seeking a full-time Family Nurse Practitioner who has a passion for working with underserved populations. This position will provide medical services in the Public Health Clinic and also serve clients of the Health Care for the Homeless Project in the downtown Minneapolis area.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities

- Perform initial and ongoing assessments of patient medical, physical and psychosocial status.
- Obtain and evaluate patient health and medical history and document in the EPIC Electronic Health Record (EHR).
- Perform physical examinations and conduct preventive screening procedures based on age and medical history; identify medical and health risks.
- Complete accurate and timely documentation of observations, interventions, referral and follow-up; develop patient care plan.
- Order appropriate therapeutic treatments; order, conduct and interpret diagnostic tests.
- Prescribe, administer and dispense therapeutic devices and legend drugs.
- Provide health education, counseling, consultation and advocacy based on needs identified in care plan. # Refer clients to other health professionals and community agencies.
- Assist with ongoing medical and nursing staff teaching programs; initiate and participate in research studies.
- Develop and maintain positive relationships with community service providers.
- Serve as an active team member of a multi-disciplinary team:
 - Attend meetings.
 - Actively participate in program planning, development and evaluation.
 - Assist with reports and special projects.

Additional Information

Work hours for this position are Monday through Friday and include working one or two evening clinics each week. Work hours will vary; clinic hours range from 7 AM to 8:30 PM. No weekend, overnight or holiday shifts are required. Successful candidates must be able to travel to local shelters and community locations for work.
